


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?


NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS






DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR FOR CHATHAM-KENT


How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?















DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR FOR CHATHAM-KENT







What broad occupational category is being recruited?












JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
